Assistance Applications - If you or someone you know needs help with something around their home, they may be able to help. You may complete your application online https://www.missiontripbirdsboro.org/assistance or you may download your application and send via email or mail (hard copies are on the table at the side door entrance). NOTE: A site selection team member will follow up with you to schedule an appointment to visit the residence and discuss the request once it has been submitted. Applicants will be informed of their selection status (and scope of assistance provided) by the first full week in July. Currently assistance is limited to homeowners living within a 15 minute drive of St. Mark's, Birdsboro.

MTBB Volunteer Registration is now Open –As you know, participants form an interfaith, inter-denominational team but, common to all, is the desire to live Christ's teaching to love and serve one another.
